## ABSTRACT

Biosystems differ from physical systems in general in that they satisfy a 'biological constraint' involving mechanisms, including the use of signs (semiosis) that oppose the fragmentation of the systems concerned. If water is such a system, this could account for the 'biological signal' phenomena reported by Jacques Benveniste and Luc Montagnier.
